You should remember

that in some cases the familiar word in Russian or Ukrainian mean opposite in Czech: e.g. "cerstvý" in Czech means "fresh", but sounds as "dry/stale" in Ukrainian.

Jihlava Zoo attending was one of the most interesting parts in Czech learning. We could see and admire not only this lovely and well-organized zoo with wide variety of animals, but also learn new words of animals' determination with adjectives appropriate to them in Czech. Everybody who will go to Jihlava should definitely see the performance with birds in the Zoo. It charms to see free flight of birds and sometimes have massage of your head when a huge eagle sits on it:)
